

# PRESCRIPTION & TREATMENT

- > When? From 4 to 6 weeks after the end of treatment, provided the immune system is stabilised. No contraindications during supportive therapy (Herceptin©) or hormone therapy.
- > Cure prescribed by a doctor (general practitioner or specialist - oncologist, radiotherapist, dermatologist, surgeon, dental surgeon, etc.). CERFA 11139\*02 form available from the CPAM.
- > Duration: 3 consecutive weeks 4 to 7 daily treatments for 18 days.
- > Coverage by Social Security: 100% of the spa package and medical fees for patients with cancer (ALD).
- > Transport and accommodation costs

Coverage is possible under the following conditions

Possible coverage subject to means testing (section 2 of the CERFA):

- 65% to 100% of travel costs
- 65% to 100% of the €150 package of assistance for accommodation

The transport allowances are calculated based on the nearest approved dermatological nearest to your home. Your mutual insurance company may also cover the costs.



# THE PATIENT MUST

- 1. Fill with his doctor the CERFA n°11139\*03 and send it to his health insurance fund.
- 2. Book his stay using mail or telephone.
- 3. Fill and send the thermal inscription with a mail or fill it online.
- 4. Choose and book a place to stay
- **5.** A confirmation of registration will be received and 15 days before the arrival, a schedule for the first day of treatment will be sent.

# CURE INDICATIONS & BENEFITS

# **POST-SURGERY**

- > Accelerated healing
- > Improvement of pathological scars: hypertrophic, retractile, or adherent scars
- > Reduction of residual lymphoedema of the arm, legs, and neck
- > Improved mobility
- > Skin preparation prior to surgical reconstruction

# AFTER RADIOTHERAPY

- > Treatment of radiodermatitis and its symptoms: xerosis, erythema, keratoses, telangiectasias, burns and inflammations
- > Cicatrisation of post-radiation mucositis in the ENT area
- > Improvement of skin suppleness and rehydration of the skin

# AFTER CHEMOTHERAPY

- > Improvement of persistent dryness of the skin and (oral and genital) mucous membranes
- > Reduction of undesirable skin effects of oral chemotherapy treatments (Xeloda® palmoplantar syndrome, Tarceva® acneiform dermatitis, pruritus, and dryness with Tarceva®) and infusion therapy (desquamation and hypertrichosis of Erbitux®)
- > Reduction of dysesthesia and peripheral neuropathy
- > Reduction of pain (bone and muscle) related to certain molecules (Tamoxifen®, Taxotere®...)
- > Acceleration of hair growth

# THERMAL CARE

- > MEDICAL FILIFORM SHOWER daily by the thermal dermatologist, draining and softening
- > FACIAL OR GENERAL SPRAYS, soothing and softening
- > PERINAL SPRAYS: soothe and moisturise the genital mucosa
- > AEROGAZE BATHS, moisturising and relaxing
- > CICATRIC MASSAGES, under thermal water, draining and softening. Progressive protocol adapted to the clinical case
- > BUCCAL CARE, gingival shower and mouth spray soothe, hydrate and revascularize the mucous membranes (Double orientation to be ticked on the CERFA)
- > DRINK CURE, detoxifying and anti-inflammatory
- > LOCAL BATHS, footbaths, manicure for palmoplantar and nail damage and nails





# REDUCTION OF SKIN XEROSIS


Evolution of the average xerosis score by VAS over 9 months

# PAIN IMPROVEMENT


### Frequency of improvement >30% of VAS pain score
