












DERMATOLOGY THERMAL TREATMENT PROGRAMME

The La Roche-Posay dermatology thermal treatment programme is effective to treat skin conditions such as eczema, psoriasis, scars, burns and the after-effects of cancer therapies. Thanks to the properties of thermal spring water, the treatments alleviate symptoms such as dryness, inflammation, scales and redness, at the same time improving patients' quality of life by relieving itching, improving sleep and reducing medication use. Mutual support between patients is also an important aspect of these treatment programmes.

INDICATIONS:

- Eczema: Atopic dermatitis in children (from the age of 6 months) and adults, secondary contact dermatitis, occupational, allergic and stasis dermatitis, perineal and genital eczema
- Psoriasis: Plaque or guttate psoriasis, nail and scalp psoriasis, with or without joint involvement
- Scars: Hypertrophic, adherent or retractile scars, postoperative scars, associated pain and functional limitation, pruritus and dysesthesia, preparation for skin graft revision and reconstructive plastic surgery
- Burns: Preparation of skin for skin graft revision, burned skin
- Other: Rosacea, prurigo, ichthyosis (fish scale disease), lichen planus (generally in adults), conditions affecting the gums and mucous membranes inside the mouth

POST-CANCER THERMAL TREATMENT PROGRAMME

The La Roche-Posay post-cancer thermal treatment programme is specially designed for people having undergone cancer therapies. It helps rehydrate the skin, improve its suppleness and soothe itching and stinging sensations. This programme also helps reduce scars and adhesions, relieve pain and improve patients' overall well-being and social life.



INDICATIONS:

- Skin and surgical after-effects of cancer therapies:
 Scarring sequelae (hypertrophy, adhesion, fibrosis, retractile), uncomfortable scars (tightness, tingling, pins and needles, pain), loss of functional mobility
- After-effects of radiotherapy or chemotherapy: Burns, persistent dryness of the skin and mucous membranes (dual-indication programme with oral mucous membrane disorders possible), redness, pruritus, handfoot syndrome, mucositis in the mouth, joint pain, etc.
- Post-treatment support: Need to practise self-care, to accept your new appearance, to share your experiences
- Conditions affecting the mucous membranes inside the mouth and the gums

CHILDREN'S THERMAL TREATMENT PROGRAMME

The children's thermal treatment programme is a natural treatment that is very well tolerated and has no side effects. Targeted treatments and specific support are offered to children from 6 months to 16 years old. Specially adapted equipment ensures they benefit from optimal conditions as they go through their care pathway.

Throughout the year, a range of fun activities for children are organised at the Thermal Treatment Centre and at the Pavillon Rose, tailored to the different age groups. Contact the Thermal Treatment Centre reception desk for more information before booking your child's treatment programme. You and your child will be given a warm welcome by qualified staff to help make sure this programme is an opportunity to acquire all the tools you need to manage your child's symptoms, in a natural environment conducive to physical and psychological well-being.

Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES:

DESCRIPTION OF THE TREATMENTS



FILIFORM SHOWER:

- Duration defined by the thermal
- Variable-pressure shower (4 to 15 bars), given by the thermal dermatologist
- Cleanses, exfoliates and reduces lesions (scales, plaques, etc.)
- Reduces fibrosis and scar adhesions, helps drain oedema.

HYDRO-JET SHOWER:

- Approved duration: 3 minutes Actual duration: 3 minutes
- The hydro-jet shower is a massaging and relaxing local thermal treatment. It softens and stimulates certain areas of your body. You will be asked to stand with your back, front or, side facing the shower, depending on the instructions of the thermal assistant giving the shower. The water jet is moved following the direction of the blood circulation to promote well-being.

GUM SHOWER AND MOUTH MIST:

- Approved duration:5 minutes and 3 minutes.Actual duration: 10 minutes
- Soothes and heals gums and the inside of the mouth. Improves saliva production.
- Treatments recommended in the event of conditions affecting the mouth.

GENERAL HYDROMASSAGE BATH:

• Approved duration: 10 minutes Actual duration: 15 minutes

LOCAL HYDROMASSAGE BATH (HAND BATH AND FOOT BATH):

- Approved duration: 10 minutes
 Actual duration: 10 minutes
- Hydrates and softens the skin. Soothes itching, relaxes and relieves tension.

FACE, BODY, SCALP, PERINEAL MIST:

- Approved duration: 3 minutes Actual duration: 8 minutes
- Water mist to soften and heal the skin. Soothes mucous membranes, reduces irritation and redness.

PHYSIOTHERAPY MASSAGE UNDER WATER SHOWER:

- Approved duration: 18x10 or 9x20 minutes
 Actual duration: 18x10 or 9x20 min
- Reduces scar adhesions, helps prepare skin for potential surgical revision. Acts on muscle and joint pain and improves functional mobility.

THERMAL SPRING WATER DRINKING TREATMENT:

- Quantity according to medical prescription issued by the thermal doctor.
- Hydrating, antioxidant and anti-inflammatory due to its high Selenium content.

2025 FEES FOR FUNDED THERMAL TREATMENT PROGRAMMES

The medical prescription should be completed and sent to your Social Security centre to request administrative funding approval. Once this has been received, you must validate your registration at the La Roche-Posay Thermal Centre online or by post. A booking confirmation will be sent to you by email, then you will be sent your treatment schedule 2 weeks before your arrival. Patients are responsible for booking and funding their own transport and accommodation.

QUICK, EASY BOOKING PROCESS:

- **1. MEDICAL PRESCRIPTION:** Consult your own general practitioner or a specialist to obtain a prescription for a thermal treatment programme funded by the French national health insurance system.
- **2. ADMINISTRATIVE FUNDING:** Send the prescription to the Social Security centre. Response within 4 to 6 weeks.
- **3. REGISTRATION:** validation of your registration at the Thermal Centre online on centrethermal.laroche-posay.fr or by post. Receipt of booking confirmation.
- **4. TREATMENT SCHEDULE:** 2 weeks before your arrival, confirmation of your treatment appointment times.
- **5. ORGANISATION OF YOUR STAY:** After receiving the funding approval, patients are responsible for organising and funding their transport and accommodation themselves. Transport and accommodation costs may be subsidised on a means-tested basis (section 3 of the CERFA form): 65% to 100% of travel costs and 65% to 100% of the €150 accommodation assistance allowance.

HOW THE FUNDED TREATMENT PROGRAMME WORKS:

- **D1:** Welcome and start of treatments at the Thermal Treatment Centre and consultation at your thermal doctor's office. Appointment given during treatments.
- **D2:** Admission formalities (payment of outstanding balance).
- D16 to D18: End-of-programme consultation with your thermal doctor, and issue of the certificate indicating that you have completed your thermal treatment programme for your own top-up health insurance company. Treatment times: between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. depending on patient numbers, Monday to Saturday. Duration of treatments: between 1 hour 30 minutes and 2 hours 30 minutes per day on average, depending on the treatments prescribed and patient numbers in the centre, with compulsory attendance for 18 days.

PRICES & FUNDING RATE:

(prices subject to change during the year)

- Treatment programme duration: 3 weeks (18 days of treatments).
- ALD ("Affection Longue Durée" or long-term medical condition) funding: 100% for 5 years for a cancer. Otherwise, 65% of the Social Security approved price.

PRICES ON 3 MAY 2024, SUBJECT TO CHANGE:

Patients with a long-term condition (ALD) or who have had an occupational accident have their treatments 100%-funded, but will have to pay the "Complément Tarifaire" set additional fee to the centre. "Complémentaire Santé Solidaire" (CSS) complementary medical insurance beneficiaries are exempted from this charge.

ADDITIONAL COSTS:

- Thermal doctor's fees: €80 to €120, 70% or 100% funded
- Transport and accommodation: Partial funding (65% to 100%) on a means-tested basis

Additional funding is possible via your own top-up health insurance






THE PARK

The thermal park forms a vast rainwater catchment area extending around the thermal centre facilities. Through infiltration and a capillary action, the rainwater collected in the park is enriched with minerals and trace elements as it slowly percolates down through the ground, transforming it into thermal spring water.

This park, so essential for the renewal of thermal spring water resources, is dotted with benches, inviting people to stop for a rest and enjoy the view as they stroll through this green natural landscape. A leisure area has also been created, including children's play equipment, pétanque (French bowls) grounds, a table tennis table and a volleyball court.

Next to the Pavillon Rose, a solarium welcomes thermal treatment programme patients who have been given a medical prescription recommending that they expose their skin to sunlight to optimise the effectiveness of their thermal treatments. 
